## GRANT OPPORTUNITY

Eulipions, Inc. is a nonprofit organization that fosters, promotes, and preserves artistic expression with an emphasis on Colorado African-American heritage and lifestyles. In 2000, Eulipions, Inc. established The Eulipions Fund at The Denver Foundation, which provides grants to generate, assist, increase, and encourage the performing arts in Colorado African American communities. Currently, grantees are selected annually.

Grants from the fund typically range from \$4,000 - \$10,000 .

## ELIGIBILITY

Applications are accepted for general operating support and funding for specific performances or programs. To qualify for a grant from The Eulipions Fund an organization must:

- Generate, assist, increase, and/or encourage performing arts in Colorado African American communities
- Be a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt nonprofit organization or have a fiscal sponsor with this status

Grants are NOT made for the following:

- Membership, affiliation campaigns, or dinners
- Creation or installation of art objects
- Debt retirement
- Endowments or other reserve funds
- Grants that further political or religious doctrine
- Travel or vehicle purchases
- Writing, publication, or distribution of books, articles, newsletters, or electronic media
- Capital campaigns
- Sabbaticals or fellowships

Applications must be submitted via email by Tuesday, September 15th, 2020 by 5 p.m.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants are required to complete the Colorado Common Grant Application, accessible at this [link](#). The proposal, and all attachments, should be sent via email to [eulipions@denverfoundation.org](mailto:eulipions@denverfoundation.org). It is extremely helpful to us if items are:

- Labeled so that each item corresponds to the item in the requested order
- Sent in a pdf format whenever possible
- Sent in as few attachments as possible

Please fill out the Colorado Common Grant “Summary Sheet Form” completely.

If your organization has a fiscal sponsor, you must also include this information: fiscal sponsor’s name, federal tax ID #, mailing address, website, CEO or Executive Director’s name, title, email address, phone #, and verification that they’re your fiscal sponsor. Be sure to include all of the items. Incomplete applications may not be considered. Applicants will be notified of the committee’s decision by mid-December.
